Nagano Prefecture, Karelia University of Applied Sciences, University of Eastern Finland and ENO Schoolnet Association are calling all high school, vocational school and university students to submit their presentation proposal in the Zero Carbon Conference 2023.

The student presentations will be 6 minutes long and should include experiences and practical solutions for reducing carbon emissions in schools, communities or personal life.

The conference will focus on mitigation of climate change and adaptation to effects of it. Mitigation is achieved either by reducing the sources of greenhouse gases or by enhancing the storage of these gases. Adaptation is possible by taking action to prevent or minimize the damage effects of climate change can cause or taking advantage of opportunities that may arise.
