

## Using the PI@ntNet and observing remarkable trees

PI@ntNet application is made for identifying of plant species. You can create the groups in different regions and in different topics in application. There is a specific group in PI@ntNet named as "remarkable trees", in where you can download somehow different and interesting individual trees in your area. The purpose of the group is to get people interested in observation of nature.

Guideline to using the application and group:

1. Download from appstore the "PI@ntNet Plant Identification" application
2. As you open the application, **you must accept the usage of GPS locating**, without that you can't download the pictures in to the group
3. Choose the suggested Northern Europe flora
4. **Crat an account** (without the account you can't download the pictures to the group)
5. Go to the footer "Groups" and search for the "Remarkable trees" -group. Join the group.
6. Photo shooting of the trees takes place in the footer "*Identification*". Check from the view, that the GPS is on. You can then take a picture with your phone or download an earlier taken picture from the gallery. If you choose a picture from the gallery there must be accepted the GPS locating.
7. Take a picture or download a picture from your photo gallery. -> choose what part of the plant is visible -> evaluate the right tree species from suggested species and choose "confirm" -> **check once again that you have accepted the GPS locating and choose "share"**

Note! To participate in the tree treasure hunt contest, mark in the "my note" field of the application: "e2a competition". This is how we distinguish those participating in the competition from other users.

8. You find your own identifications by the footer "Profile"
9. At a final stage you go to the group "Remarkable trees" and add the identification by choosing a "+" sign. If you have not allowed the usage of GPS locating, there will not be any identifications in your account.

You can also use the application only for identifying a plant either in public or in private without sharing it in the application, without using GPS location or even without creating an account. You can keep your observations private by choosing instead of sharing the footer "later". If you choose the footer "share", identifying of a plant takes place interactively with other users, because they can either validate the identification of your observation or propose some other plant species. By creating an account you can also validate identifications by other users. We wish you interesting moments with the identifications!
