INSTRUCTIONS

- **Create a 3D model of a butterfly using only upcycled materials.** Give a second life to broken, used, or forgotten items.
- **Format:** Must be a 3D construction (no drawings or videos).
- **Materials & Size:** No limitations—let your imagination run wild! (When in doubt: If it's old, 3D, and looks like a butterfly - it's perfect!)
- **Originality:** We want unique, humorous, and original ideas. Avoid Pinterest clichés.
- **Photos:** Take three photos from different angles. Ensure the background is clean and free of unrelated items. No collages.
- **Description:** Include a short list of the materials used and any special details about your work.

RULES & CATEGORIES

Submission Limit: Maximum of 5 entries per school.

Language: All data must be in English using the Latin alphabet!

Deadline: May 15, 2026.

ENTRY CATEGORIES

A: Kindergartens (Ages 5–6)

B: Primary schools (Ages 6–12)

C: Secondary and high schools (Ages 12–19)

D: Teachers

Requirements: Your email must include 3 JPEG photos (do not embed them in Word documents) and the following details:

- Entry Category (A, B, C, or D)
- Full name and age of the author(s)
- Full name and email of the mentor
- School name and full address
- Country

JUDGING & PRIZES

An international jury of art experts will judge entries based on presentation, creative use of materials, and original humor.

Diplomas: The top five projects in each category will receive an official ENOArt diploma.

Certificates: All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

Gallery: All entries will be featured in our online gallery and final video presentation.

EXHIBITION IDEA

Since your students will likely create many butterflies, why not host a local exhibition? Consider hanging them in your school library, hallways, or even on trees in a nearby park to share the message of change with your community.
