ENO Environment Online is a global network of schools and communities for sustainable development. founded in North Carelia, Finland, in 2000. Since the beginning we in ENO have planted trees together with schools and communities. Our network is active in over 100 countries. We have two annual days for planting standing together with the UN; for [International Day for Biological Diversity 22 May](#) and for [International Day of Peace 21 September](#). And of course you can participate and plant trees at any day throughout the year depending on a suitable season for planting in your country.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

1. PREPARATIONS AND PLANNING:

- **Choose a date;** Remember that you can plant any day/week. Join a global ENO community on social media platforms.
- **Choose local tree species and suitable places for planting.**
- **Ask your local celebrity to join:**
Ask if your students or group can pose questions to her/him and take photos.

Our Message for the day
